

## **Drop-In Gutter Guard Instructions**

- 1.) Starting at one end, slightly lift the shingles, and slide the back edge of the gutter guard under the shingles. Next, push the front edge against the lip of the gutter. Repeat this process with the next gutter guard, avoiding gaps and overlaps.**
- 2.) At the end of the gutter, you may have to shorten the length of the gutter guard. If so, simply cut off the excess material.**
- 3.) On the outside corners, cut a 45 degree angle off the opposite ends of the two adjoining pieces. Slide under the shingles and push onto the gutter to form an accurate corner joint.**
- 4.) On the inside corners you must allow for the splashguards. Make a 3/4" cut out of the gutter guard to clear the splashguard. Next, cut a 45 degree angle off the opposite ends of two adjoining pieces. slide the guard under the shingles and push onto the gutter to form an accurate corner joint.**
